

Ms. Bodi comes to the Center with over 26 years of experience within the Racine Unified School District. Most recently, Ms. Bodi worked at Mitchell Middle School as a counselor. As High School Coordinator, **Noelle Steffen** manages after school academic support. Ms. Steffen has worked in parochial schools as a language arts teacher, both at St. Catherine's High School in Racine, and St. Anthony's High School in Milwaukee.
